March 7

March 8

(SAMPLE ITINERARY)

March 14

Depart from your hometown to Florence, Italy.

March 15

Upon arrival into Florence, you will be met and transferred to the Hotel Beacci Tornabuoni located on the Via Tornabuoni, one of the most elegant streets in Florence. All major attractions and great shopping are within walking distance of the hotel. Please join us for a Welcome Wine and Cheese Party this evening.

March 16

After breakfast, you will depart for a tour of the Chianti Region. During your drive out of Florence, your guide will acquaint you with the area and give you an overview of the surrounding wine regions. The Chianti Region reaches from south of Florence to north of Siena. You will visit stunning vineyards and enjoy a fascinating selection of wineries. You will learn to distinguish the main varieties of grapes during your tour.

March 17

After another wonderful Tuscan breakfast you will depart for your wine tour. Brunello is one of Italy's most famous wines. It springs from the classic, gentle rolling hills, cypress groves, and small medieval hilltop villages of Southern Tuscany. The historic town of Montalcino is the centre of Brunello production.

The famous Brunello winery has been named producer of the year numerous times. After your tasting, perhaps have lunch in a magnificent Tuscan castle where the chef has been awarded a Michelin Star. The castle overlooks one stunning Tuscan countryside. You may also wish to visit the ancient Abbey of Sant Antimo.

March 18

Today you are free to enjoy all that the city has to offer on your own.

March 19

After breakfast, you will depart for another wonderful day of wineries. On the glorious rolling hills of Tuscany, south of Siena, sits the town of Montepulciano where the marvelous Vino Nobile is produced. Nobile is one of the outstanding, traditional Tuscan wines.
